Welcome to the British home of natural petal confetti

We grow acres and acres of tall, elegant delphinium flowers. They will all be handpicked to become wedding confetti petals, but before they are harvested, we open up our Confetti Flower Field to the public... Such an enormous expanse of colours - it is a spectacular sight to see!

We invite you to come and enjoy the field. You can wander around the wiggly paths that wind through the flowers. Spend some quality time with friends and family in the countryside. Take in the beautiful rural views. Simply escape from the everyday world: The flowers are such a tonic to busy modern life – come along to soak up their colour and soothe your soul.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Inside the flower field:

The pop-up **Confetti Café** - we sell hot and cold drinks, cakes, and ice creams on a takeaway basis.

The **Flower Stall** - you can buy bunches of freshly picked delphiniums to take home.

The **Shop** - we have a small range of our confetti petal products and a few other special items for sale.

Artist in Residence – Hayley Reynolds – she'll be painting in the field and a selection of her colourful artworks will be for sale.

The Confetti Flower Field is a temporary event on our working farm.

The flowers are planted in a different field every year – so each year we build the event from scratch. That means that there are no permanent buildings, structures, or pathways. There is also no running water or electricity on site.

Farm fields are bumpy & uneven underfoot!

Please wear appropriate footwear and clothing for the outdoors.

Remember, fields are full of plants and insects that might scratch, sting or bite. Please take care!

There is very little shade or cover in the confetti fields. Please come prepared for all weather conditions!

We will post daily updates on our website and social media to let you know what it's like in the field. We might recommend sunhats or wellies depending on the weather.

Please check before you travel, plan and pack accordingly. Thank you.

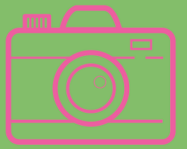

OUR FLOWERS:

- We have five colours of annual **delphiniums** - white, blue, purple, light pink and dark pink. We also plant a multicoloured area of mixed up seeds - because it looks great! Some years the delphiniums grow as high as 6' tall.
- We grow a selection of **cornflowers** - they make tiny little fluffy confetti petals. These come in all sorts of colours including a striking black shade.
- And we plant various **wildflowers** too - these are not only beautiful, but wonderful for the bees, butterflies and other insects.

Each year the flowers are replanted in a different field, in variously sized stripes of colour, dependant on our confetti petal needs. This means that every year the flower field looks a little bit different!



Prams, Pushchairs, Wheelchairs and Mobility Scooters:

Because the ground surfaces are simply farm fields, they can be tricky to negotiate with small wheels. When it's hot and dry, the soil gets very dusty. When it rains it can get a bit muddy. These surfaces are quite challenging.

We will only close the confetti field in the event of extreme weather. Please check our website/social media before you travel.

We want everyone to enjoy the peace and tranquillity of the countryside and feel relaxed and happy when visiting our flower field:

Please be careful when walking around the flowers. Keep to the mown pathways. Don't cut, pick, or dig up the flowers.

You are very welcome to bring a picnic along. There is lots of grass around the edges of the flowers where you can sit down – please don't eat in the middle of the flowers. Please do not bring barbecues, stoves or picnic chairs and furniture.

No alcohol is allowed. Bins are provided for your litter.

To protect our visitors and our crops, ball games, sports equipment, bicycles, scooters, and large toys etc must be left in your car (or at your own risk at the entrance).

Please don't bring radios, music players and musical instruments.

There is no access to any surrounding fields. Please do not climb fences or hedges. Please do not walk in our farm crops. Thank you.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE BOOKING:

Please purchase a ticket for each person in your party aged 5 and over. (We do not offer concessions.)

Your tickets will be checked in your vehicle when you arrive. (Please have your email confirmation handy!)

If you are meeting up with people but you are travelling separately, each car must buy their own tickets.

Our tickets are sold in timeslots when you want to arrive. You are welcome to stay as long as you like, but we politely ask that you limit your visit to 2 hours for the benefit of other visitors. We open each day at 10am and the last admission to the field is at 3.45pm. The flower field closes at 5pm. There is no entry outside these times.

If you are visiting as a large group, we'd advise that you give us a call before booking. We can accommodate small minibuses in the car park but not full size coaches.

Access to the flower field is along single-track roads, bumpy farm tracks and across grassed fields. Please note - These roads are unsuitable for extra long, wide or low vehicles.

Access will be signed from the B4084 (Persore to Evesham road). We operate a one-way entry/exit system. PLEASE FOLLOW THE YELLOW AA SIGNS (not your satnav)!

Sadly, due to the location of the field, we do not recommend walking to our event. For more info about public transport please read our "Getting Here" page.



Come rain or shine!

We will only close the confetti field in the event of extreme weather.

If we must close the field, you will receive a full refund.

IMPORTANT:

All tickets are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

We are unable to amend your booking if you make a mistake. Please check your selections carefully at each stage of the buying process. Your ticket is only valid for the session that you have purchased and cannot be used for any other session.

TOP TIPS FOR PLANNING YOUR VISIT:



Our quietest times are weekday afternoons.

If you are looking for a mindful escape, why not come and visit then?

The Confetti Café offers drinks and treats. If you'd like a more substantial meal we suggest you head into Pershore. Our local town has lots of lovely cafes, pubs and restaurants. There are also picnic benches at Pershore Bridges, the Abbey Park and by the riverside in town.

We offer free car parking right next door to the confetti field. After you check in with our gate staff, you will be directed into our car park.

You are free to move back and forth between your car and the flowers. (If you need to run back for a broly or a sandwich you can!)

We provide straw bales for seating, but they can get a bit damp after rains or on dewy mornings, so we'd suggest bringing a picnic blanket to sit on.

There is always a mad rush to buy tickets when they first go on sale. PLEASE DON'T PANIC! We never sell out straight away. If the website is busy please come back later.

If you are booking a photoshoot with a professional photographer make sure you arrange a place to meet - it's a very big field!

We have a disabled parking area close to the flower field entrance - please ask the car park marshals if you need to park in this area.
